## Introduction

The National Archives of Namibia is keeping government publications (official publications) in a separate collection. Since the Namibia Library and Information Service Act (Act 2 of 2000) it has been given a legal mandate to have government and parastatal publications deposited. The Act prescribes that government offices and bodies established by an Act of Parliament have to deliver twenty copies of each publication to the National Archives, which catalogues and keeps one copy and passes the remaining 19 copies on to the National Library for further distribution to libraries. The aim of this provision is to make government information available country-wide.

As Namibia does not have a central government printer, and the production of publications is done on the level of individual directorates and offices using private printing firms, and as even for serial publications like newsletters and annual reports there are frequent changes of the responsible staff, it is a very work-intensive task to keep track and enforce the legal provisions. Due to the understaffing of the National Archives, there are therefore still considerable gaps in this collection. The Archives strives to fill these gaps retrospectively by various means.

To use this list, the following should be understood:

- The Government Publications Collection archives only publications that are typically issued by most ministries and parastatals and are key to understand their mandate and operations, such as annual reports, newsletters, news releases and policy papers.
- Any other publications, especially scholarly and popular monographs that are issued by some ministries, are normally not taken into the Government Publications Collection, but into the general Archives Library. They can be found through the NAMLIT and ARCAT databases.
- The numbering system within each ministry etc. is standardised and self-explanatory. If a number has been omitted, this means that either the relevant organisation does not issue that type of publication, or that it has never been obtained by the Archives.
- Serial publications, such as annual reports, are listed only with the title but not with every present issue, because this would require too frequent updates of this list. To identify which issues are present in the archives, the NAMLIT database (which is updated with every new issue) has to be consulted.
- Policy papers and workplans are listed in detail, and also catalogued in the NAMLIT and ARCAT databases.
- News releases and “ephemera” such as leaflets, flyers and other publicity material are usually not listed in detail, and also not catalogued in detail in the databases.

Items from this collection should be ordered with the archival group code AP.

## **23/01      Government Gazette of the Republic of Namibia**

Note: The Government Gazette publishes Government Notices, Acts of Parliament, General Notices, and advertisements that by law have to be published in the Gazette. The Government Gazette started being published immediately after independence on 21 March 1990 with continuous numbering, beginning with no.1. It continues the “Official Gazette of South West Africa” which was published between 1915 and March 1990.

To order Government Gazettes, readers should request the specific Gazette number.

The National Archives also keeps older Gazettes for sale, while recent Gazettes are available from the printing company which holds the current printing tender.
