Introduction

Ovamboland in German colonial times

During German colonial rule until 1915, the area known as Ovamboland was outside the “police zone” and only nominally claimed as part of “German South West Africa”. The German government did not have a permanent representation in the area. It only sent occasional envoys to the various independent Ovambo rulers and secured some loose cooperation agreements, with a focus on facilitating the contracting of migrant labourers to the farms and industries in the police zone, in particular from 1908 onwards to the diamond fields.

The office of Resident Commissioner

When South Africa conquered the German colony in 1915, it established a “Resident Commissioner Ovamboland” (RCO), based at Ondangwa, in the same year. The first RCO was Major Charles Nicholson Manning. When Manning was became Chief Native Commissioner (based at Windhoek) in 1920, he was succeeded by Carl Hugo Linsingen “Cocky” Hahn (Oshiwambo nickname “Shongola”). Hahn was succeeded by Harold Lionel Pritchard Eedes (Oshiwambo nickname “Nakale”) in 1946-1954.

The office of the RCO functioned with minimal staff, as the Commissioner operated according to the principles of “indirect rule”, relying on the powers of traditional rulers and their councils who were enticed to cooperate with the colonial administration by various monetary and non-monetary favours, by food aid in the case of famine during droughts, but also intimidated with military action against uncooperative rulers such as Mandume ya Ndemufayo in 1917 and Ipumbu ya Tshilongo in 1932.

Purpose and activities

The main purpose of the Resident Commissioner’s office was to secure and maintain the flow of migrant labour to the Police Zone. This reflects strongly in the records. The control of activities of Europeans in the area (traders and missionaries) was well as securing the border to Angola were further important functions.

The records

The records cover only the period 1919-1955. Earlier records of the RCO are contained in the fonds RCO Resident Commissioner Ovamboland (1915-1923; finding aid 1/1/52) which is partly overlapping with the NAO fonds.

There seems to be no organic reason for the division between the RCO and NAO fonds, other than that they were received at different times in different transfers by the National Archives.

Later, the responsibilities of the Resident Commissioner were taken over by the Commissioner-General Oshakati, fonds KGO (1957-1977). This fonds is still unlisted and therefore inaccessible.

Related archives

Substantial related records relating to NAO are found in the fonds South West Africa Administration SWAA (1920-1960; finding aid 1/1/46, but more easily identifiable through the database FILES).

Also, the personal papers of Resident Commissioner C.H.L. Hahn are available and provide an important complementary source: Accession A.0450 (finding aid 2/31).

After the tenure of the three commissioners Manning, Hahn, and Eedes, who could exercise relatively high autonomy in their administration, the native commissioners were increasingly subject to supervision and interference by the central Native Administration offices in Windhoek and Pretoria.

Preservation

Large sections of the fonds NAO consist of flimsy, acidic, and deteriorating carbon copy paper. Frequent photocopying has in the past already led to partial loss of paper fragments with text.

Therefore, substantial sections have been digitised for preservation and access. The files digitised by January 2019 have been marked as “DIGITISED!” in this finding aid. The originals of these sections are closed for consultation, and only the digital version may be used. The catalogue records in the FILES and NAN databases link directly to the digital version on the server.

Digitisation will continue for the rest of the NAO papers.

Literature

While there is a wealth of literature (mostly in Finnish) about the Finnish Mission in Ovamboland during the period in question, and also a number of works dealing with migrant labour and its effects on the region, there is very little focusing on the colonial administration.
