Introduction

This fonds consists of the original enumerators' forms of the 1991 Census.

While originally collected for statistical purposes, census records become in the long run important sources for historical, sociological, and genealogical research. However, as the base data collected by the census are person-related and confidential, they will not be released after the statutory period for government records of 30 years, but will remain restricted for a considerably longer period which will have to be determined by a future Namibian privacy legislation. It can be assumed that the restricted period will extend to approximately 100 years.

The present listing is not an archival finding aid and is based on a basic transfer list provided by the creating office.

The extent of the material, which is not yet adequately sorted and packaged, is estimated at 55 linear meters.
