Introduction

In precolonial times, the area of today's Zambezi Region was under the suzerainty of the Lozi Kings who resided in southeastern Zambia. In 1890, Germany and Britain negotiated a treaty (known as the Heligoland-Zanzibar-Treaty) which included an agreement that the area which became known as the Caprivi Strip, consisting of the Zambezi region and an eastern section of the Kavango-East Region, became part of the German colony South West Africa. The Caprivi Strip is named after the German Chancellor at the time of the treaty, General *Count Georg Leo von Caprivi di Caprara di Montecuccoli*. But it was only in 1909 that Germany established an administrative presence in the Caprivi strip, with the resident commissioner Kurt Streitwolf.

During the First World War, Caprivi was occupied by British forces from Southern Rhodesia (now Zimbabwe). Due to the remoteness of the area from central Namibia, the colonial government administration for the Caprivi after World War I was first done by the Government of the Bechuanaland Protectorate. Therefore, records about the early colonial administration of the Caprivi can be found in the National Archives of Botswana, Gaborone. For a list of relevant records in Botswana, see Accession **AACRLS.169** (available digitally on Archives server, V:\nan\AACRLS\169\)

From 1929 to 1939, administrative control was executed from Windhoek. Records about this period can be found, scattered under various headings, in the archival fonds **SWAA**.

From 1939 onward, East Caprivi was placed under direct control of the Department of Native Affairs in Pretoria. The records about this period have been repatriated from South Africa, and now form the archival fonds **KCA** (Commissioner Eastern Caprivi).

Only in 1971, responsibility over the administration of Caprivi was returned to Windhoek.

The capital of the Caprivi was at Schuckmannsburg until around 1933, when the administrative centre moved to Katima Mulilo.

In May 1972, a Caprivi "Homeland" (Bantustan) was established. This was abolished with the Namibian constitution of 1990. Records of various departments of the Caprivi Bantustan are in the archives: **CAF, CJU, CWO, CAH, CPS, CMF, ACS, CED, CGS, CAE**.

The Magistrates of Caprivi

A deputy magistrate (H. Neale) was stationed in the Caprivi as from 1 Jan 1921.

Magistrates, also acting as "Native Commissioners", were stationed in Katima Mulilo from 1939 onwards. They were:

The Magistrates did not only hear court cases but had many other administrative functions. Therefore, these Magistrate files contain also, for example, records about agriculture and infrastructure works.

The Katima Mulilo Magistrate files do also, unlike the other magistrate files from other districts, include the records of customary courts of the Fwe and Subia *Khutas* (royal councils/courts).

All files listed in this findaid have also been entered and are searchable on the COURT database.
