Introduction

This accession was donated in 1993 by Mr Brian Thorn, owner of the "Camelthorn" antique shop in Windhoek, who had acquired it with other items from an undisclosed source.

It consists of private letters of German Namibians who were interned during World War II in South African internment camps. Despite the fact that it was not allowed to write details about the camp (a few letters have been censored by cutting passages out), they provide some insight into the situation of the internees and their contact with home.
