Introduction

Biographical information

Jane Katjavivi, born in Leeds (England), worked as a journalist and copy editor in London before she came to Namibia in 1989. She established the publishing house *New Namibia Books* and the bookshop *Onganda y'Omambo*. She served as a founder member, board member and long-term chairperson of the *Association of Namibian Publishers* (ANP) and the *Namibia Book Development Council* (NBDC). She also served as Namibian representative on the *African Publishing Network* (APNET).

Provenance

These papers were donated in 2003 and reflect part of Jane Katjavivi's activities in ANP, NBDC and APNET. However, substantial ANP and APNET administrative files had earlier been handed over to her successor in the chairmanship of ANP.

Appraisal and description

The donated material consists of archival material proper, as well as grey literature and publications.

The archival material was arranged according to its organisational provenance but still awaits more detailed arrangement and description. The same applies to the grey literature. Both categories as well as the periodicals on African publishing were accessioned at the National Archives.

Some of the donated published material (periodicals) was transferred on to the National Library.

The transfer also included a number of published books and brochures on publishing and related issues, which were initially set aside to be integrated in a planned library in the "Book House". As the Book House library was never established, this material still awaits a decision on its final repository.

The accession totals 1.41 linear metres (National Library and Book House material excluded).
