Introduction

Provenance

These photos were donated by Mr Horst Müller from Mainz, Germany, in 1990. They had been rephotographed from a scrapbook with cut-out images from the contemporary German illustrated magazine "Weltspiegel". The photos were registered in 1990 in the photo collection, but only registered as an Accession in 2011.

The images convey an impression of the contemporary popular depiction of the colony in German illustrated media.
