Introduction

Provenance

These publications by SWAPO or the United Nations were transferred by the National Museum of Namibia, History Department, in March 2012, as they were either surplus or considered outside the Museum's collection policy.

Their provenance is diverse, but a large part – which can no longer be clearly identified – originated from a collection of SWAPO publications donated to the Museum by Ambrosius Amutenya (many of those in multiple copies).

Sorting and Appraisal

There was no original order in the collection. The items were sorted into five categories: SWAPO periodicals, SWAPO monograph publications, United Nations publications, UNTAG and 1989 independence election material, and Other.

Where applicable, individual duplicate items were used to fill gaps in the periodicals and the pamphlets held by the National Archives. Otherwise, duplicates were taken to the surplus/exchange collection.

The material amounts to two standard archival boxes.
